

## **EASTERN CLAIMS CONFERENCE FINANCIAL AID POLICY FOR NEW YORK ATTORNEYS**

The Eastern Claims Conference (“ECC”) has available a financial aid policy for New York attorneys who wish to attend our annual conference and obtain CLE credits, but who are unable to attend due to cost considerations.

No later than 30 days prior to the date of ECC’s Annual Conference, applicant must submitted a completed application together with a duly executed copy of the last filed Federal Income Tax Return (Form 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ together with W-2’s, 1099’s and all accompanying schedules). There will be no charge to submit this application.

Upon receipt of this application, the applicant will be advised of the ECC’s decision within 10 business days of our receipt of duly executed and requested information.

The following are the guidelines that the ECC will apply in awarding financial aid to NY attorneys:

Unemployed attorneys	Full scholarship
Attorneys with income up to \$35,000	75% discount
Attorneys with income \$35,000 to \$50,000	50% discount
Attorneys with income above \$50,000	No discount
